### Responsibilities & Tasks:

- Greeting walk/run participants and directing them to the registration area
- Greeting festival attendees
- Handing out programs/maps or assisting with them connecting to the digital option
- Answering questions and providing directions

- Excellent communication skills – English language
- Knowledge of EHS – mission, values, programs, and services
- Comfortable interacting with festival attendees
- Good customer service skills – detail oriented
- Positive attitude!

### Commitment and Scheduling:

- 7:30am – 11:30am (4 volunteers needed)
- 9:30am – 1:30pm (6 – 8 volunteers needed)
- 1:00pm – 5:00pm (6 – 8 volunteers needed)
- *\*Volunteers must attend the entirety of the scheduled shift.*

### Role Requirements:

- Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older to participate independently
- Volunteers 8-15 years of age may participate alongside a parent or guardian

- EHS Pets In the Park Volunteer manual provided in advance
- Any additional training will be provided on site prior to beginning your shift
