

Pets In the Park – PALS Medical Booth

Tours of the PALS mobile unit will be given throughout the event, and the Medical Team will be focusing on providing information on dental care for companion animals. Dr. Disa Boyd will be available for the “Ask the Expert” activity and will be available to provide information to both volunteers and participants.

- Executing duties as assigned by the Medical Team lead
- Providing attendees with directions or answering any questions they might have
- Promoting activities occurring on the Main Stage

- Excellent communication skills (English language) – ability to maintain a conversation comfortably
- Knowledge of EHS – mission values, programs, and services
- Ability to stand for 2-4 hours at a time
- Good customer service skills – detail oriented

- Any additional training will be provided on site prior to beginning your shift
