

## Pets In the Park – Take-Down Team

The Edmonton Humane Society (EHS) is proudly celebrating the 30<sup>th</sup> year anniversary of the Pets in the Park festival which brings together people and their pets to celebrate the incredible impact they have on our lives, while giving back to animals in need. For EHS, our goals are simple:

- Engage with our community and supporters
- Increase fundraising revenue over previous years
- Provide opportunities for staff & volunteer engagement

Volunteers will be assisting the site manager with disassembling everything at the end of the festival. Volunteers will take down booths, tables and other structures and will deliver the to designated vehicles for removal from the site. This role is detail-oriented – volunteers must ensure that everything is taken apart, packed up properly, and labelled correctly in order to be stored when they are returned to EHS. Volunteers will also assist with cleaning the event area to ensure that the park is left in good condition once the festival has completed.

### Responsibilities & Tasks:

- Taking direction from the site manager – completing tasks as assigned
- Loading items and delivering them to their designated locations to be removed from the site
- Assisting with taking down tents and other structures – making sure all activities and events are packed up properly
- Safety is a top priority – ensuring that concerns are passed along to the site manager
- Ensuring that only EHS assets are being disassembled and loaded and **not** those belonging to vendors or sponsors
- Other various duties as assigned

### Skills:

- Ability to lift 50+ pounds
- Work quickly and efficiently – complete tasks as assigned
- Ability to stand and walk for 2-4 hours at a time – able to multiple complete physically labourious tasks
- Detail and safety oriented

### Commitment and Scheduling:

- Sunday, June 26, 2022 – 4:00pm-8:00pm (10 volunteers needed)  
*\*Volunteers must attend the entirety of the scheduled shift*

### Role Requirements:

- Volunteers must be 16 years of age or older

### Onboarding & Training:

- EHS Pets In the Park Volunteer manual provided in advance
- Any additional training will be provided on site prior to beginning your shift
